- 7 Conveyance (lease and release). John Pearson of Westminster to George Taylor and other Trustees. Fleetbanke and Intack closes in Tollerton in trust for the poor of Tollerton, Alne, Flawith, Tholthorpe, Aldwark and Youlton 3, 4 June 1695
- 8 Final concord. John Pearson to George Taylor and his wife Elizabeth. 20 acres of land etc. in Tollerton Trinity 1695
- 9 Conveyance (lease and release). Robert Wrightson of Youlton, only surviving trustee, to Joseph Slack of Alne, clerk, and John Theakston of York. Fleetbank and Intack closes in Tollerton, to be re-conveyed to other [named] Trustees 1, 2 January 1754
